Gino Georg Gori - Age 58

Beloved husband, father, son, brother, uncle, nephew, cousin, and friend, died peacefully at home in Eden Prairie, MN surrounded by his family on September 1st, after a courageous 19-month battle with stomach cancer.

Gino was born on January 19th, 1965 in Morristown, New Jersey. His family moved to Eden Prairie, where he met and then married Kristi Lea Olson on April 18th, 1992. Gino and Kristi shared 31 precious years of marriage together and raised two beautiful daughters, Shelby (30) and Karina (27).

Gino was a Senior Wireless Engineer at UNFI, formerly known as Supervalu, for 34 years. He loved to be active in his free time. In his early years, Gino played football and was an all-star soccer player. While working at Supervalu in his early 20's, Gino joined a softball league which ignited his passion and love for the game and he continued to play in leagues for the next 25 years. He loved to bike, work out, golf, travel, sing his favorite songs, and always showed affection to animals. Gino will forever be remembered for his kindness, quiet confidence, empathetic soul, playful demeanor, and his ability to make friends from all walks of life, noticing the little things and finding common ground with everyone he met. even had "Prima La Famiglia" (Family First in Italian) tattooed on his bicep. He lived by those words with his whole heart and soul, cherishing time spent with his wife, girls, and beloved pets; Josie, Enzo, and Finn.
