



## Glen Henry Asmus

July 10, 1925 - February 12, 2022

Asmus, Glen H. Age 96, of St. Anthony, died peacefully at Abbott Northwestern Hospital on February 12, 2022. He was kind, faithful, and honest; he was a man of integrity. Glen is survived by his daughter, Mary; sister-in-law, Carol Asmus; cousins; nieces and nephews; and other family members and friends.
