Nordstrom, Grace Mae Born March 4, 1913 at Howard, SD to parents, Frank & Pearl (Young) Hoffman. Lived on the farm and attended school in the Howard, SD school district. On Feb. 10, 1934, Allan Levi Nordstrom and Grace Mae Hoffman were married in the Lutheran Church of Howard, SD. Allan was the son of Charles & Anna Nordstrom of Canova, SD. In Dec. 1934, they moved to Minneapolis, MN and Allan was employed by Sears Roebuck & Co. for 36 years. Grace was employed by Minneapolis Honeywell Co. for 32 1/2 years. After retirement, they spent time in their Florida home in the winter and summers in their Minneapolis, MN home and also on their boat docked on the St. Croix River at Stillwater, MN. Grace was a charter member of the Honeywell Women's Club (Honeybellies) and the Ladies Auxiliary of the VFW, St. Louis Park Post in St. Louis Park, MN. Both were members of the Lost Spur Country Club, Mendota, MN, Pool and Yacht Club of Lilydale, MN and the St. Croix Yacht Club of Stillwater, MN. Allan passed away Dec. 10, 1996 while in Florida.
