Leech, Grayle Glenn (75) passed away on April 28, 2020 after a sudden short illness not related to Covid-19. He was born on August 8, 1944 in Mpls., MN and graduated from Minnetonka High School. He went on to attend Stout State University in Menominee, WI earning an engineering degree. He served his country in the US Army in Viet Nam (68-70) and received an Air Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Army Commendation Medal and the Bronze Star.
