Stebbins, Gregory Lee, age 73, of Inver Grove Heights, passed away peacefully January 6, 2024. Preceded by his parents, Charles and Haldis Stebbins, Greg is survived by siblings Richard (Green Valley, AZ) and Melissa (Dale) Doerr (Minneapolis, MN), nieces Erica Alitiem, Sarah Doerr, Meredith Weitz, nephew Chad Stebbins, and ten grand nieces and nephews.

Greg was born and grew up in West St. Paul, graduating from Henry Sibley High School in 1970. Alongside his father, he volunteered for the West St. Paul Park and Recreation Board, particularly at the then-annual Halloween Bonfire and Hot Dog Roast. Greg worked in banking for his entire career, focusing on lockbox operations. He retired from Wells Fargo in 2017, after 34 years of nearly perfect attendance. In his retirement, he faithfully volunteered at the food shelf of Neighbors, Inc., in South St. Paul.

Greg's interests revolved around sports, movies, travel and cars. He kept up with the Minnesota Twins and maintained a love/hate relationship with the Minnesota Vikings. He was always willing to discuss their successes and shortcomings. Greg loved movies, both televised and on the big screen. Pre-covid, he, his sister and brother-in-law went "to the movies" most every weekend.

Greg enjoyed several trips to Europe, particularly Germany and the country of

his heritage, Norway. He took several cruises to Alaska, the Hawaiian islands and the Caribbean, and he relaxed in the warm destinations of Florida, California, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, and Mexico.

Following in his father's footsteps, Greg traded automobiles about every three years. He regularly visited the dealerships on South Robert in West St. Paul and had friendly ongoing relationships with several sales representatives. He was most proud of his newest car, a Hyundai EV.

Greg was a loving son, brother and uncle. He was kind, polite, and always of good humor. He will missed by all who knew him
