



## Guadalupe Maria Brummer

November 12, 1928 - June 13, 2022

Guadalupe "Lupe" Maria Brummer (Bosquez) was a caring wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend. She left this world on June 13th 2022 to be reunited with her husband and savior at the age of 93. Lupe was born in Minneapolis and graduated from South High. She also briefly attended the University of Minnesota. Lupe had a dedicated 47-year career as a nursing supervisor with the city of Minneapolis. In 1950 she was united in marriage to Alfred Brummer, they were together for 62 years.

Lupe loved traveling, spending time with family and was always available to provide a helping hand. She was also proud of her Mexican heritage. In 1947, with over 1000 people in attendance, she was the first young lady from Minneapolis to be crowned Queen at the annual Mexican Fiesta in Saint Paul that celebrated Mexico's Liberation from Spain.

Preceded in death by her husband Alfred Brummer; parents Concepcion and Jesus (Gutierrez) Bosquez; brothers Salome, Antonio, Pablo, Juan, and Roberto.
