Skalle, Hans J. Minneapolis restaurateur, passed way 30 Dec at age 93. Born in Lunde-Sogne, Norway, Hans went to sea at age 14, eventually becoming the youngest Chief Steward in the Norwegian Merchant Marine. He crossed the North Atlantic 69 times during WWII, was awarded Norwegian Defense and Freedom Medals. Met wife, Mavis, while captain of the Waldorf Astoria Empire Room in NYC. Moved to Edina to manage Interlachen CC for 16 years, guiding its growth and development. Built Camelot restaurant in '64, successfully bringing award- winning French Cuisine to Mpls. Survived by Mavis; son, Hans (Sara) Skalle; daughter, Heidi (Val) Hoffmann; grandchildren, Clare and Annika Skalle; Courtney and Kelsey Hoffmann.
