Feldman, Harold D. Beloved husband of Mary Ann, passed away at age 90 at their home in Minneapolis on October 27, 2016. Born Sept. 30, 1926, Harold grew up in Perth Amboy, NJ. During World War II, Harold enlisted in the Navy as a teenager, and served on the USS Rocky Mount, the 7th Fleet Flagship in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater. After graduating from Rutgers University, Harold worked as an actuary, and then joined the computer industry with Sperry Rand in the 1950s. Harold met Mary Ann Janisch of Saint Paul while she was a graduate student at Columbia University. They were married in New York City at St. Paul's Chapel of Columbia University on Sept. 14, 1957. In 1959 Harold was transferred to the Univac Division of Sperry Rand in Mary Ann's hometown of St. Paul, and she joined the Minnesota Orchestra as program annotator in 1966. During their 59-year marriage they shared passion for music and the great outdoors. Harold is survived by his wife, Mary Ann, their Papillon dog, Jorjie Fleezanis Feldman, as well as his nieces Ruth Feldman and Roni McLain, and nephews Robert Feldman, Chuck Lipton, Frank Goldstein and Richard Goldstein. He was preceded in death by his parents, Isaac and Bella Feldman, and his siblings Abe, Charles, Ida, Leo, Helen and Marge.
