Nelson III, Harold Victor (Vic), age 75, passed away peacefully on January 13, 2022, in Medina, Minnesota, after a valiant battle with dementia. Vic was born to the late Harold and Ruth (Warwick) Nelson on January 7, 1947, in Poughkeepsie, New York. He spent his formative years in Rochester, Minnesota, with his siblings, Nancy, Ron, and Wynn. Vic attended John Marshall High School and enjoyed running track throughout his high school career. Upon graduation, he attended two years at Rochester Junior College and then two years at the University of Minnesota. Vic also served in the Army for two and a half years and was ranked SP5 at his discharge. He married Joan Lillie on October 12, 1968, and they had three children, Victor in 1971, Erin in 1973, and Megan in 1980. Vic's career began in 1972 as a circuit designer at Magic Dot. In 1975, he began working as an engineering manager at Continental Circuits. Then, in 1978, he founded and was CEO of Circuit Check, Inc. in Maple Grove, Minnesota. He sold his business in 2001 and retired. Vic had an entrepreneurial spirit and a strong work ethic. He also had an intelligent and innovative mind. He cared for his employees like they were family and appreciated his time with them. Vic was a champion tennis player and also enjoyed waterskiing, playing golf, and fishing with his family. "Vegas Vic" thoroughly enjoyed gambling and spending time in Las Vegas. Some of Dad's favorite things were cruising in his corvette, cheering on the Vikings, and enjoying his Crown Royal and any variety of sweet treats. We lovingly referred to his leisurely style of dining out as "Vic Nelson style of dining." He

loved to enjoy the evening together and was never in a rush. Vic was a devoted Dad and Grandpa. He spoiled his grandchildren with bubble gum, pop, and an early introduction to pull tabs. Many of his grandkids played hockey, and despite always being cold, he would bundle up to go cheer them on at the rink. We will remember Dad for his kind and caring heart, quick wit, gentleness, fun-loving spirit, baritone laugh, and generosity.
