(PARDON THE PUN) WE JOINED THE US ARMY TOGETHER 18 NOV 1948 IN FORT RILEY KANSAS, BASIC TRAINING AND THEN TO FT BENNING(SAND HILL ) GA , HARRY TO ORDONANCE, MYSELF TO AN AN ARMORED DIV, TANK DRIVER. WE WORKED TOGETHER FOR A YEAR FOR DONAVAN CONST , ELEC HIGHLINE, NOT MY BAG BUT WAS HARRY'S LINE OF WORK UNTIL RETIREMENT AND MADE A GOOD LIVING FOR WIFE, HELEN, SONS, DARRELL@ ROGER. WE SLOWLY DRIFTED APART BUT DID GET TOGETHER MANY TIMES EVEN AFTER MY WIFE CAROL AND I MOVED TO A FARM IN WESTERN WISCONSIN.
