



Henrietta Orlaine Warwick

March 23, 1929 - November 19, 2023

Warwick, Henrietta, PhD died November 19, 2023, in St. Paul, MN. She grew up on the Iron Range, graduated from St. Olaf College, taught organ lessons at Martin Luther College for a year, and then married Warren Warwick. They spent several years outside Minnesota for his medical training and Army duty. When back in Minnesota, she pursued graduate studies at the University of Minnesota while teaching Freshman English. She published a concordance of the works of the Roman poet Vergil and obtained her doctorate in 1977. She enjoyed research, including finding links between medieval legends and history, and documenting the path of a supernova in monastic records across Europe. She substitute taught occasionally at St. Paul Academy and Gustavus Adolphus college. In between this, and raising children, she was a member and president of the Minneapolis Peripatetics. Henrietta is remembered as a cheerful and loving person with a sparkling smile. She and her husband liked to travel and take long walks; friends knew they were welcome to drop by anytime. She is survived by two daughters, Marion and Anne (Bill), two godchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews. Funeral at St. Mark's Cathedral, Minneapolis, Thursday 30 November 2023 at 10:30am.
