He grew up in South Mpls, graduating from South High, joined the National Guard and spent some time in Europe during World War II (Bronze Star). He was married to Doris Marsh in 1942. After the war he graduated from the UofM as a Civil Engineer and went to work for Minnegasco where he worked for 35 years. He continued in the National Guard and was called to active duty in the Korean War where he served in the 84th Engineer Construction Bn. as an Engineer Company Commander building the Freedom Gate Bridge and serving as Engineer for Panmunjon and the UN Camp in Munson-ni. He was a Lt. Col. when he retired from the Guard after 26 years of service. He was Senior Vice President of Operations at Minnegasco when he left his job to work with Campus Crusade for Christ where he and Doris served 20 years. He was active in his church, Emmaus Lutheran and served as Chair of the AFLC Commission on Evangelism. Gene was an avid gardener and loved sailing.
