Howard was 97 and was preceded in death last year by his wife, Lolita, to whom he was married for over 70 years. Howard and Lolita owned and operated John's Place, a Chinese restaurant and Minneapolis landmark located at 6th and Hennepin until its closing in 1968. Howard was a member of the Shriners' Zuhrah Temple AAONMS, Knights Templar, MW Grand Lodge of Minnesota, Optimist Club of Golden Valley, and the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, S.J., USA. He also was the oldest member of Westminster Presbyterian Church.
