Wolff, Irma Alma Irma Wolff, formerly of Golden Valley, MN died February 23, 2006 in Hibbing, MN. She was born April 22, 1915 in Montevideo, MN to Pastor Otto C. and Hannah (Freese) Wolff. She was baptized and confirmed by her father at St. John's Lutheran Church in Montevideo. She graduated from Montevideo High School in 1932, obtained teaching certificate to teach in rural schools in 1933, and taught 9 years in rural School District #61 North of Maynard, MN. She moved to Mpls in 1944, graduated from St. Cloud's Teachers College in 1946 with a 2 year teaching certificate, and continued her education at the U of MN, earning her Bachelor of Science Degree in 1953. She took a teaching position at L.O. Jacob School in Coon Rapids in 1946 and taught there until retirement in 1984. Irma was a longtime member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in N. Mpls where she taught Sunday School, sang in the choir, and served as church organist for 26 years. She also worked at the North Memorial Hospital Gift Shop for 16 years.
