Corbo, Jack R. Inver Grove Heights Known as the "Jack of Hearts" to all age 3 Heart Transplant Recipient 6.26.04 4.14.08 Passed away in his mother's arms on April 14, 2008 while waiting for his second heart transplant. Preceded in death by his grandfather, Robert L. Hicks (Champaign, IL). Survived by his father, Todd Corbo, mother, Robin Hicks-Corbo, and twin brother, Cooper; and many loving relatives and fans across the world. Jack received a heart transplant at the University of Minnesota Children's Hospital Fairview on Oct. 17, 2004, at the age of four months, due to a viral infection that infected his own heart. His angel heart was damaged in transport and he required a new one. He bravely and humorously waited again for the past four months, entertaining all who crossed his path. 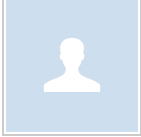

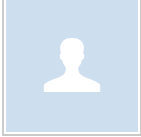

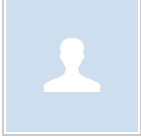
