Lower, Jack of St. Anthony Village, died on January 19, 2014. He was born in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin on February 28, 1921, to parents Gilbert and Jennie Lower. He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters, Bettye Tohill and Ruth O'Connell. He is survived by two sisters, Marjorie (Fred) Roycraft of Chippewa Falls, WI, and Beverly (William) Lacina of Ham Lake, MN, and by numerous nieces and nephews with the family spanning four generations. Jack earned electrical engineering degrees at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, and at Purdue University in Indiana. His WW2 military services were at Wright Patterson AFB in Ohio and Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland. He worked briefly in Chicago before joining Honeywell Aerospace for 36 years. Jack was a mainstay at the family lake cottage in Wisconsin. After his retirement he spent 20 years in volunteer tax preparation. He also volunteered financial counseling for the handicapped. Jack was a prolific reader, using Kindle and other sources for popular books, especially books on historical fiction.
