Hallaway, Jacqueline Age 94, of Mpls, died at home on October 11, 2015. Born in Epernay, France, the heart of the Champagne region, on February 3, 1921 to Marius and Andree (Lehmann) Duvignau. Jacqueline lived there until the outbreak of WW II, eventually settling in Paris. Following the liberation of Paris, she met her husband, Ben, an American soldier and Dodge Center, MN native.
