Bullock, James B., Jr. Age 96, passed away peacefully December 27, 2020 at Emerald Crest Memory Care in Victoria, MN. We thank them and Grace Hospice for their excellent care. Jim was born in Joliet, IL in 1924, graduated from Spencer (Iowa) High School, and served in the Army during WW II in the Pacific. He received his Baccalaureate degree from Drake University in Des Moines, IA where he was active in theater and chorus. He worked for Dayton's in NYC and Minneapolis, and then for North Star Distributors. During years living in Denver, he loved driving his original Mustang convertible with the top down through Colorado mountains. He lived for decades at The Oak Grove Apts near Loring Park and was active in neighborhood committees, and Friends of Loring Park, and volunteered thousands of hours at Abbott-Northwestern Hospital. He was fascinated by historic architecture and extensively studied building plans of UK and European great homes and gardens. He is preceded in death by his sister, Betty (Bullock) Naas, and his parents, Mabelle and Jim Bullock Sr. He is survived by Bob Naas, his brother-in-law, as well as survived by his niece, Dr. Peggy Naas and her husband, Dr. Steve Mestitz who provided Jim years of care and attention. Also survived by a second niece, Cheryl (Rand) Alexander, a nephew, Brian Naas, and six grandnieces and nephews.
