James G. Cardle, loving husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, respected pediatrician and mentor to many, went home to be with his Lord and Savior January 3, 2025 while in Austin, Texas. Jim was born on March 10, 1933 and was raised in Edina with his older sister Mary by his loving parents, Earl & Harriet Cardle. He graduated from the first class of Edina High School in 1951 and attended the University of Minnesota for his undergraduate and Medical School degrees. He married his sweetheart Carolyn Blaul in 1956.

Jim interned in Torrance, California, followed by a Pediatric Residency at the University of Minnesota. He served in the U.S. Army Medical Corps at Ft. Wolters in Mineral Wells, Texas, before joining Southdale Pediatrics in Edina, where he practiced for 36 years retiring in 1999. He served for decades, both as a volunteer and Board Member at Community Emergency Services, with the Hennepin County Child Protection Services Guardian Ad Litem Program, Bible Study Fellowship, and was instrumental in establishing Children's Hospital in Minneapolis.
