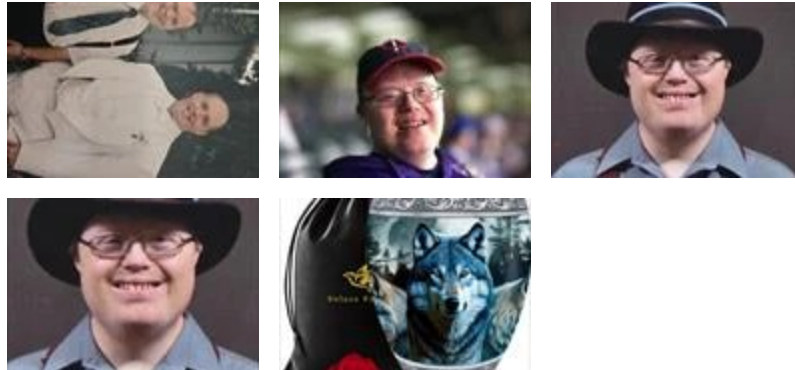

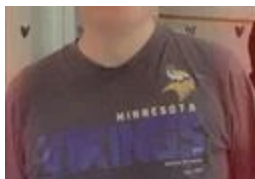

I'll miss the feeling of his hugs, the sound of his laugh and the feeling of holding his hand but most of all the memories we didn't get to make. I love you buddy 💜

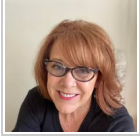
