Jane loved spending time with her family, gardening, traveling, cheering on

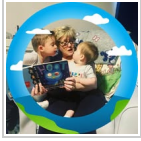
the Detroit Lions and Minnesota Vikings (dual loyalties) and spoiling her grandchildren.
