Jean Lois Alsop passed away on February 3, 2017. Jean was born on April 13, 1926 in Spring Grove, Minnesota to Rudolph and Bertha (Sylling) Tweeten. In 1948, she completed the five year public health nursing program at the University of Minnesota where she received her Bachelor of Science and Graduate in Nursing Degrees together with her Public Health Nursing Certificate. She successfully completed the Minnesota nursing examination and became a registered public health nurse. Jean was first employed at Minneapolis General Hospital and later at the Visiting Nurse Service of the City of Minneapolis.
