Jean worked many years the ICU, Cath Lab, and Post Anesthesia Recovery Unit (PACU). Prior to Retirement she was one of several Administrative Managers at NMMC and even continued part-time after

retirement. Jean received many distinguished nursing awards and recognition for her positive attitude and compassionate care. Jean enjoyed sailing in Lake Superior and Caribbean with family and friends as well as gardening, reading, traveling and being with friends.
