



## Mrs. Jean Ann Howe

January 29, 1934 - November 13, 2019

Howe (Hinman), Jean Ann 85, passed away peacefully following a lengthy illness on November 13, 2019, in Minneapolis, MN. Jean was born in Minneapolis on January 29, 1934, the daughter of Albert A. and Harriett E. (Platt) Hinman. Jean graduated from West High School in Minneapolis in 1951. Following graduation, Jean attended and graduated from the University of Minnesota Senior College, Class of 1953, and began a long career in advertising and branding. Jean worked for Campbell-Mithun Advertising and Jim Braddy Photography in Minneapolis, as well as J. Walter Thompson Advertising in Chicago, IL. It was in Chicago that she met her future husband, Richard Warren Howe, and she joined the staff at his creative agency, Dick Howe Studios. Jean and Dick were married in January, 1962, and relocated to Dallas, TX, in 1972. In 1979, Jean signed on with The Richards Group (TRG) in Dallas, where she worked as Executive Administrator for thirty-six years, until retiring in 2015. Jean earned an extensive reputation within TRG and the Dallas business community as a consummate agency professional, garnering numerous accolades and awards, highlighted by a cover story for her TRG role with D CEO magazine in 2015. In addition to her husband and parents, Jean was predeceased by a brother, Albert A. Hinman, stepson Jeffrey L. Howe, and granddaughter Jessica A. Howe. Jean is survived by a daughter, Lucinda L. Pulito and her husband, Richard; a son, Richard P. Howe and his wife, Herminia; and stepdaughter Penney R. MacPherson, as well as eight grandchildren, Seth A. Turman, Micah H. Turman, Zachary S. Turman,

Michael R. Pulito, Kathryn V. Pulito, John A. Howe, Joshua A. Howe, Darcy A. Ferro, and numerous great-grandchildren.
