It is with great sadness that we announce the very sudden and shocking passing of Jeanine Louise Gilbert at her home on Thursday, January 9, 2025. Jeanine had just celebrated her 58th Birthday with a family lunch on December 1st, 2024.

Jeanine Louise was born on December 1, 1966, to Duane and Barbara Gilbert in Robbinsdale, MN. She later moved with her parents in 1966 to Watertown, WI, then returned to Minneapolis, MN with her family in November of 1969. Jeanine remained in Minneapolis until moving with her family to Brooklyn Park, MN in late 1987.

Jeanine attended Fourth Baptist Christian School from Kindergarten to 12th grade and graduated high school in 1985. Throughout high school, she performed in many plays, musicals, and choir. She also loved art and submitted several oil and watercolor paintings, pottery, and calligraphy to be entered at the MN State Fair.

Jeanine attended the University of Minnesota from 1985 until the winter of 1988 in pursuit of an Elementary Teaching Degree. Her goal and dream were to become a third-grade elementary teacher. Jeanine contacted a severe case of Mono the winter of 1988 and was medically forced to withdraw from college. She never returned to college.

Jeanine had several job positions over the years. Some included Regis Salons, MN Auto Auction, Angma Health, and Allina Health. Jeanine's final professional position was with Revo Health working in their medical insurance and billing area. Jeanine had finally found a job and co-workers she appreciated, and they appreciated her. She loved this job very much.

Jeanine attended Fourth Baptist Church from Infancy to her passing. When she graduated high school, she began teaching 4 & 5 year old Sunday School and Church and also worked with the 4 & 5 year old Awana Cubby program. Her ministry service was from 1985 until 2023.

Jeanine's passing was very unexpected, very sudden, and very heartbreaking to all who knew her. Even some she had not personally met, but she conversed with daily through working remotely.

Jeanine was unable to have her own children due to uterine and endometrial cancer early in life. However, her life revolved around her nephews and nieces, her Honorary nephews and nieces, and the many children she taught over the years. The impact of her love and teaching will never be forgotten.

Jeanine is survived by her sister Eileen Law; Nephew Charles (Anna) Law, Nieces Cara (Ben) Borchardt, Shae Law, Skye Law; Great-Nephew Isaac Law and Great-Niece Evelyn Law (parents Charles & Anna Law); Honorary Niece Nicole Webinger and her children Emerson and Maya.
