Jeannine had a fantastic sense of humor and was fast with a witty comment or come-back. She also took walks every day. Even when her health started to decline, she continued to walk several blocks daily using her walker.

Towards the end of her life, Jeannine was diagnosed with dementia. She showed great courage as the disease progressed. She retained her sense of humor (and sweet tooth) right up to the end. She entered hospice several weeks before her passing and received excellent support from her hospice and assisted living team in her final days. Jeannine passed away peacefully, without any suffering.
