



Jerry Marvin Beckman

March 24, 1932 - September 27, 2024

Beckman, Jerry Marvin age 92, passed away at home September 27th, 2024. He was born at home on the family farm in Nowthen, MN, on March 24, 1932, to Oscar and Nellie (Hoberg) Beckman. Jerry was the 16th child of 19 siblings. He was a 1951 graduate of Anoka High School and drafted into the Army in 1952 during the Korean War. After his service he enrolled at the Minnesota School of Business and received an accounting degree, from there he began his professional public accounting career working as an independent Certified Public Account, lasting over 61 years. He worked until he was 85, he loved his job. In May of 1958 he married Shirley M. Baumhofer, of Montevideo, MN and together they had 3 sons and made their life in Minneapolis. He is survived by his wife Shirley; brother Wendell (Dee) Beckman; sister Barbara (Joe) Ridge; sons Dean (Kathy) of Swanville, John (Dawn) of Maple Grove, Lyle (Jane) of Blaine; grandchildren Katie Beckman, Daniel Beckman, Amy (Joe) Gubbels, Rachael (Gabe) Munson, Jennifer (Chris) Lutgen, Brandon Beckman, Andrew Beckman, Nicholas (Jessica) Beckman, Benjamin (Liah) Beckman; 8 great-grandchildren and many, many nieces and nephews.
