Joan Lucille (Jody) Morio, 94, of Bloomington, Minnesota passed away suddenly on Thursday, May 28, 2026 at Friendship Village in Bloomington.

Joan was born on March 28, 1932 at Mercy Hospital in Cedar Rapids, Iowa to parents William F. and Marie (Murphy) Morio. She was a 1950 graduate of Immaculate Conception High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Joan studied and became a registered nurse at Mercy Hospital School of Nursing in 1953, then earned a BS degree from Loras College in 1958. She moved with her parents to Minneapolis, MN and worked as a registered nurse for several years in the Twin City area hospitals. Later, Joan went to the graduate School of Public Health at the University of Minnesota and earned a Master's Degree in 1972. She worked in Public Health in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area for several years and later joined the administration staff. Later in her career, she taught various nursing classes for Gustavus Adolphus College (St. Peter, MN) as well as Hennepin Technical College in suburban Minneapolis.

Joan "Aunt Jody" will always be lovingly remembered by her family as the one who kept the family informed and connected. She lovingly cared for her parents, especially for her elderly mother, Marie, for several years.

Joan was a faith-filled, lifelong Catholic.

She also was a loyal Minnesota Twins baseball fan, enjoyed shopping, cooking, playing golf and Bridge.
