



Joanne Mae Stark

April 15, 1933 - May 31, 2021

Joanne Mae (nee Alberts) Stark, 88, of Bloomington, formerly long-time resident of Fridley, passed away May 31, 2021. She was preceded in death by her husband, Donald William, parents John and Minnie Alberts, sister Vera (Robert) Bronlewee, brother Charles Alberts, parents-in-law August and Emma Stark, brothers-in-law Clarence (Bertha, Marion) Stark, Raymond (Eleanor) Stark, and Norman Stark and sister-in-law Myrtle (William) Schultz. Joanne was born April 15, 1933 and grew up on a farm near Buffalo Center, IA. She was baptized at First Baptist Church in Buffalo Center. She attended country school and graduated from Buffalo Center High School on May 22, 1950. After graduation Joanne moved to Algona, IA for employment and eventually to Minneapolis.

On June 2, 1956 Joanne was united in marriage with Donald Stark at Berea Lutheran Church in Richfield. She and Donald had one son and two daughters. After marriage, they lived in Minneapolis and then Robbinsdale,

and in 1960 moved to Palmdale, CA for a two-year work assignment. Upon their return from California, they lived in Crystal while building a home in Fridley. Three years later, following the May 6, 1965 tornadoes, they rebuilt their home where they lived until Donald's death in 1985. Joanne remained in their Fridley home until she moved to Presbyterian Homes in Bloomington in November 2014.

Joanne was a long-time member of The Lutheran Church of the Triune God, 5827 Humboldt Avenue North, Brooklyn Center. A funeral service will be held at Triune God on June 7 at 11 AM with visitation one hour prior to the service. Access the church from 57th Ave N, go north on Logan Ave which becomes Lilac Dr and then curves into 59th Ave N and then turn right at Irving Ave for church. Burial following at Hillside Cemetery, 2600 19th Ave NE, Minneapolis. Rev. John Fehrmann officiating.
