Jodi Ann Zenti, age 57, passed away unexpectedly in a car accident on July 17, 2020. She grew up in Farmington, Minnesota with her parents, Fred and Dorothy, and her siblings, Jeff and Sara. She attended the University of Saint Benedict in Saint Joseph, Minnesota, where she earned a Bachelor of Arts in Chemistry. Jodi loved learning, so she continued on and went to medical school in Des Moines, Iowa, where she met her children's father, Alberto Zenti. Together, they completed residency in Springfield, Illinois before coming to Minnesota. Jodi was absolutely committed to her job as a Family Practice doctor. She loved speaking to her patients, and she loved how they surprised her and challenged her. Jodi cared deeply for her colleagues; her office team, Amber, Shannon, Ben, and Jann were like her second family. Her passion for helping others guided her in everything that she did. Jodi will be remembered by those who knew her as someone who supported us all endlessly. No matter how crazy her children's ideas were or how far away they were, Jodi was the first person to offer her love. She was a passionate reader, an unstoppable long-distance bicyclist, a lifelong learner, a diehard football fan, a fierce badminton competitor, and our home. Her laughter, her fluffy hair, and her Burberry perfume will stay with each of us forever. Her children were all so well-loved by her. There will be a very small, private memorial at the Washburn-McReavy funeral home. 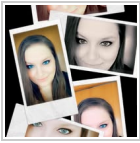

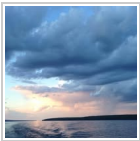
