John Philip Douglass, 73, of North Oaks, Minnesota, passed away from sarcoma on June 8, 2019.

John is preceded in death by his parents, Bernard and Ruth Douglass; brothers, Robert and Daniel; and infant son, Phillip.

John was born in Chicago on June 7, 1946. He graduated from North Park Academy in 1964, where he was a three season athlete and all-state football player. He received his BA from DePauw University in 1968 and went on to earn his JD from Northwestern University, and MBA from the Carlson School at the University of Minnesota.

John married Emily Rice on November 29, 1969. They enjoyed nearly 50 years of a faithful and happy marriage. As a young man, John worked for his father's business, Warner Candy, in Chicago. After receiving his law degree he worked for Green Giant in Le Sueur, Minnesota, and from there moved on to Ecolab in Saint Paul. He retired from Ecolab as Vice President of Finance in 1998. Throughout his life John was an active volunteer with many charities and served on boards at Minnehaha Academy, North Park University and the Covenant Church. He loved relaxing at the cabin in Boulder Junction, Wisconsin, walking the beach in Harbert, Michigan and travelling to new places, especially National Parks. John also spent countless hours on the golf course.

John is survived by his wife, Emily; daughters, Hilary (Nathan) Sonstegard, Heidi (Jey) Carlson, Heather Douglass and Holly VanderHyde; grandchildren,

Phillip, Madilynn, Caroline, Emma, Bjorn, Elise, Alexander and Ingrid; siblings, Susan (Martin) Sandstrom, Wylie (Ardyth) and David (Susan); nieces and nephews.
