

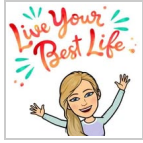


## John Geier

Geier, Dr. John G. Age 75, of Plymouth, passed away September 26, 2009. Dr. Geier straddled the academic and workplace worlds for over forty years--teaching and researching at the Universities of Minnesota, Arizona, Michigan, and Wisconsin. He is best known for his pioneering effort--the DISC assessment systems--that improve work/life performance. His works appear in 35 languages; over six million copies have been sold. Dr. Geier was preceded in death by his parents, John and Irene (Bock) Geier; and sisters, Margaret Bruce and Marlene Benson. He is survived by wife, co-author, and business partner, Dorothy Downey; former wife, Marian Gardiner; four sons, John (Galina) Geier, Dan Geier, Mark (Michelle Heitz) Geier, and Phillip (Judy) Geier; three daughters, Kathy (Dan) Blanchette, Suzanne (Terry) Parker, and Thea (Rick) Dillner; 23 grandchildren; 6 great-grandchildren; and brothers-in-law, Don Bruce and Robert Benson. Survivors also include stepchildren, Rick (Terri) Downey, Cort (Jill) Downey, Doug Downey, and Tracey (Gary) Lee; 7 step-grandchildren; and 1 step great-granddaughter.
