At nearby Fort Lewis Army base, Jack served as a dentist there and was a happy, active, dedicated military man. Children four and five, Jane and Kurt were born there. After 3 years of military service, the family returned to St. Cloud, Minnesota where Jack had a private practice for several years. He was very well liked and known as an excellent dentist. He left private practice to work as one of the dentists at the St. Cloud Reformatory. In his later

retirement, he lived in Palm Springs and Loma Linda, California for a while, then moved to Scottsdale and then Phoenix, Arizona. While living away from MN he had the pleasure of happy friendships with David and Julie. Jack moved home May 2019 for his last living days to be close to his family.
