Noble, John Small Jr. Jack, Jackie, Dad, Grandpa, The Colonel, Honey - age 88 of Edina and Bloomington passed away peacefully at the Minneapolis Veterans Home on November 23, 2021 where he had lived for the past 20 months. Jack was born to John and Jannette Noble on June 18, 1933 and grew up in Deephaven, graduating from Deephaven High School in 1951. 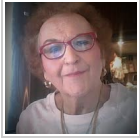

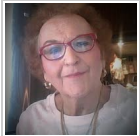
