John Martin Stiglich was born January 7th, 1964 in Hibbing, Minnesota to Stan and Arlene Stiglich. He had an older sister Stephanie and younger brother Mike.

John graduated from Hibbing High School in 1982. He attended Northwestern University in Chicago from 1983-1987, graduating with degrees in Economics and Math. He took his first actuarial job at AON in Chicago. After a few years he moved back to Minnesota, where he worked at MSI insurance in Arden Hills and met Jolene Mayden. They were married on July 31st, 1993 on a riverboat on the St Croix River near Stillwater and made their home in Shoreview.

In July 1998, John and Jolene were blessed with the birth of their daughter Madison Lee Stiglich. "Madio" as he liked to call her became the joy of his life.

John's joy doubled when their son Samuel Lowe Stiglich was born in August 2001.
