



## John Donald "Moe" Dvorak

Dvorak, John Donald "Moe" age 81, of Prior Lake, MN, died on Thursday, 03/21/2013 at Fairview Ridges Hospital in Minneapolis, MN. Moe was born 06/11/1931 in Montgomery, MN to W. J. and Sophia (Rynda) Dvorak. After his formative years in Montgomery, Moe served in the U. S. Army from 1953-1955, and subsequently graduated from St. John's University (Collegeville, MN) in 1957. Moe was an accomplished athlete and fondly remembered his years playing football at St. John's under Hall of Fame inductees, Johnny "Blood" McNally and John Gagliardi.
