Jon R. Bravinder, age 83, of St. Louis Park, passed away peacefully on July 29, surrounded by friends and family he loved so dearly. A devoted man of faith, Jon lived his life grounded in the teachings of Christ, with unwavering love for his family and those around him. His deep commitment to God was evident in the way he lived - with integrity, kindness, and an encouraging spirit that blessed everyone he encountered.

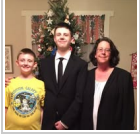
