In 1956, Joe and Colleen moved their family to Minneapolis. Joe worked in the insurance industry for 38 years as a salesman and agency owner. He and Colleen retired in 1997 and moved to Phoenix, while summering at their cottage on Lake Lida in northern Minnesota. Joe loved to fish. He especially enjoyed fishing with his grandchildren. In his late 80's Joe was the racquetball Champion of Arizona in his age group. Joe continued to play golf, achieving a handicap of three at one time. He enjoyed playing cards at his country clubs, and at the Edina Library with kind younger men who picked him up when he gave up driving. Joe and Colleen moved back to St. Louis Park in 2016 just in time for winter. Church attendance and his faith was important to Joe. He was a long-time member of Westwood Lutheran Church where he sang in the choir. Joe is predeceased by his parents & three sisters: Marie Posz (Conrad), Dagny Christiansen (Holger), and Sylvia Grant (Wally). He is survived by his wife Colleen, daughter Sandra Gilbert (Bruce) and son Alex (Susan), four grandchildren, two step grandchildren, and 11 great grandchildren, as well as his large extended family and friends.
