Quigley Joseph Sigurd, age 89, died Sunday, May 15, 2005 in the St. Mary's Medical Hospital, Duluth, MN. Joe was born July 25, 1915 in Lake Park, MN to Joseph & Petra (Grafslund) Quigley. He married Eileen (Lomasney) on August 27, 1942. He graduated from the U of MN and Iowa State with his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. Joe joined the military as an officer in the Veterinary Corps in 1941 where he served in China during WWII and in Vietnam. He retired as a full Colonel in 1974 and went on to teach on a part-time basis at the Univ. of MN Veterinary School where he was a co-founder of the CENSHARE Program specializing in human- animal relationships.
