



Joseph Frank Raschka

August 21, 1947 - June 29, 2024

Joseph "Joe" Frank Raschka was born in Springfield, MN on August 21, 1947 to Joseph and Mary Raschka. He passed away at his home in Blaine on June 29, 2024. Joe attended Lamberton High School, where he played football and wrestled. After graduation, he attended Mankato State College. He was drafted into the Army in 1966. Joe went to Viet Nam in March of 1967 where he was wounded and received the Purple Heart Award. Joe had a stroke on June 24, 2024. He contracted Parkinson's Disease because of his exposure to Agent Orange, which was a contributing factor to his death.

After his discharge, he attended Winona State College. He earned a degree in Business Management in 1972. He started working for Briggs Transportation and then on to the Tennant Company for 27 years. Joe enjoyed golfing and flying into Canada for his annual fishing trips. He loved spending time with his children and grandchildren.

In 1974, Joe married Ann Cuckie in Fort Dodge, Iowa. They had two children. He is survived by his wife, Ann; sons, Jeff (Jessica) and Chad (Sarah Osborn) Raschka; 8 grandchildren, Kaleigh, Courtney, Ethan, Amelia, Zoey, Ramona, Corbin, and Jaxson; sisters, Kathryn Rueda and Jan (Ralph) Brown; 7 nieces and nephews, 14 great-nieces and nephews; and sister-in-law, Karen Amman and her family.
