Judith Ann Schneider "Judy", age 81, passed away peacefully in her sleep on April 20, 2026 at her residence in Minnetonka, Minnesota. Most recently, Judy made her home at Amira Choice in Minnetonka, where the wonderful staff cared for her as her Alzheimer's Disease progressed. Her
