July 27, 1934 - March 18, 2025

Julia (Feenstra) Kusters, age 90, of Edina, MN passed away on March 18, 2025. Julia was born July 27, 1934 near New Holland, South Dakota to Charles and Della (Van den Hoak) Feenstra. She attended the New Holland Christian School.

On March 8, 1955 she was married to Alvin Kusters. During the Korean conflict he was serving in the U.S. Army at Fort Bliss near El Paso, TX where they lived until he was discharged. They moved to Rapid City, SD while Al attended the School of Mines, and then to Minneapolis where Al found employment. Al and Julia were blessed with three sons, Wayne, Jay, and Dan during these early years of marriage.

After Julia's sons finished grade school Julia took necessary courses to obtain GED. She then continued course work at St. Mary's School of Nursing in Minneapolis and graduated with the Registered Nurse Certification. She worked at a number of hospitals but found the most joy working Private Duty assignments, showing compassion to the sick, elderly, and lonely.

Julia volunteered in the community, church, her children's schools, and was very active in the functions of the Salvation Army during the 1990's where she served as President of their Women's Auxiliary. She enjoyed reading religious authors and handiwork (e.g, tatting).

She is survived by sons Wayne (Leslie) and Jay (Mary) of Mpls., five grandchildren, Tegan (Dan) Rambeck, Chloe (John) Sutley, Jacob Kusters, Anthony Kusters, Christina Kusters, four greatgrandchildren, Phoebe, Oliver, Micah, and Evelyn and brother Lee (Eleanor) Feenstra.

She is preceded in death by her parents Charles and Della , her husband Alvin, brother C.A. Feenstra, and son Dan Kusters.

The memorial service will be on Thursday, April 10th, 11:00 AM at Calvary Christian Reformed Church, 5300 France Ave. S., Edina, MN with visitation at 10:00 AM. Private burial at Fort Snelling National Cemetery.
