Julia loved working with children and assisted in religious education at First Universalist Church, where children gravitated to her calm and loving demeanor. Julia attended Lake Country School and Brightmont Academy and completed one year of study at Augsburg College. She suffered a stroke in 2018 and hoped to continue her education as her brain continued to heal. She recently worked at Nordstrom.
