Julie Idzorek (Stadheim) of Saint Louis Park, MN passed away at home on January 24, 2025 at the age of 66. She went on to work in various U of M medical laboratories for 42 years, retiring from the Advanced Research and Diagnostics Laboratory in 2022. Julie was a true Gopher hockey fan for 45 years and lover and supporter of the U of M Marching Band. Julie was an award winning quilter. She subscribed to the quilters' "whoever dies with the most pieces wins" philosophy, finishing well over 100 quilts in her career. She was a longtime member of Minnesota Quilters and South Minneapolis Quilters. Julie had a huge passion for Norwegian Elkhounds. Most recently, she owned and showed Bjorna and Trygg, both AKC Grand Champions. Julie also chaired the Norwegian Elkhound Association of America Canine Health and Research Committee. She was also an ardent Jackson Browne fan. Julie attended many of his concerts over the years, most recently on a beautiful summer evening at the Quarry amphitheater in Saint Cloud, MN. Julie would speak fondly of her

many travels to Villa Elsa in Acapulco, Vieques PR, Hawaii, Provence France, and throughout the United States and Canada.
