July 25, 1921 - October 2, 2024

Constantine, Katherine (Kay) age 103, of Minneapolis, passed away Wednesday morning, October 2, 2024, in her home. She was born near Bield, Manitoba. Her early childhood was spent on a remote farm with her large Ukrainian family and by the end of her life she had traveled the world with her beloved husband. She was a valued member of St. Olaf Church and its choir for over two-thirds of a century. She displayed her strength, wit, elegance, and charm while blazing trails for women in business. Her 100th birthday was recognized by Queen Elizabeth II and Canada's Prime Minister. She was named an honorary citizen of Winnipeg for service to the city. She enjoyed and supported the opera, orchestra, and Minnesota North Stars. But most of all, people were her passion; she gave fully of herself to all and was cherished by many. This loving matriarch leaves a grieving family. She was preceded in death by her husband of 63 years, Sydney R. Constantine. She is survived by her son Charles Sydney Constantine (Peg Marek) and daughter Katherine Anne Constantine (Michael Joseph Bono); grandchildren Elizabeth Victoria Forsberg (Shawn David Forsberg), Anne Katherine Constantine, Katherine Bono Constantine (Benjamin James Chapman), and David Constantine Bono; and great-grandchildren Moira Lisbeth and Muriel Anne Forsberg, and Cedar Bono Chapman.
