Lundell, Kenneth Paul 89, died peacefully on April 27, 2012, in the company of family members, in St. Louis Park. Ken grew up in a farming family in northwestern Minnesota. He married Joyce Anderson in 1943. Drafted at the end of WWII, he served in the Philippines and Japan. After his discharge, he earned a degree from the University of Minnesota and attended North Park Seminary, Chicago, where he was ordained a minister. He served in the Evangelical Covenant Church as pastor, missionary to Japan, administrator in the Department of World Missions (Chicago), and chaplain. After his retirement, he volunteered faithfully at Loaves & Fishes and as a chaplain at Edina Care Center. Ken was an avid family historian and wrote two books of personal and family stories and memories. Ken is survived by his wife, Joyce; children, Jonathan (Jo Chamberlain), Rosemary, Juliann (Jim Tarsney), and Don (Gillian Robinson); grandchildren, Christian and Catherine Tarsney; and sister, Phyllis Paulson.
