Kevin Barton Hanson, age 71, of Bloomington, MN passed away on June 21st, 2025 after a short battle with Pancreatic Cancer. He was born on March 23, 1954 in Lovell, Iowa, son of the late Kenneth Barton and Phyllis Salma Hanson.
