Hulsebus, Kris age 66, of St. Paul, died January 26 from the re-emergence of a cancer. Kris attended high school in Carroll, Iowa and graduated from Univ. of Iowa. She taught Jr. High in St. Paul for several years before getting her law degree from UMN Law School. After her admission to the MN Bar in 1976, she spent over 35 years practicing real estate and public interest law. Kris was the first woman partner at Oppenheimer, Wolff and Donnelly. She joined the Attorney General's office in 1991 and then transferred to the Pollution Control Agency in 1999; retiring in 2011. Most passionate about her governmental and environmental work, she was regarded as a teacher, mentor and tough negotiator when it came to polluters. The guiding passion in her life was her spiritual quest and examination of reincarnation, transpersonal psychology and belief in the connectedness of all life. Kris enjoyed gardening, frequent trips to France, country music and caring for stray cats. She is survived by siblings, Laurie Hinckley, Las Vegas, NV, Anthony (Susan) and niece and nephew, Zachary and Zoe, Robbinsdale, MN. She will be forever missed by a wide circle of friends whose hearts she deeply touched.
