Kris made many close friends in the Twin Cities, who became part of her life. She worked for DynaVox, by advising their engineers on design changes to their voice synthesizers for non-verbal people. She also represented DynaVox, speaking at conferences for the handicapped. She traveled often, to Europe, the Caribbean, and back to Colorado to visit her family. She loved going to the Colorado mountains when visiting, and even going white water rafting. She is remembered as having a child-like faith in the Lord Jesus for most of her adult life. She had a sense of humor, doing pranks and other things for a laugh. Kris' laughter was her trademark. She was preceded in death, by her parents Albert & Genevieve Hass.
