Tueting, Lavone Wylie age 96, of Minneapolis, died peacefully on May 25. Lavone was born on May 30, 1916 to Viola and John M. Wylie, the first of five children. She is survived by her children, grandchildren, Jonathan (Sarah), Sarah (Dan Lemaitre), Joel, Wylie, and Alex (Nelson), five great-grandchildren, her sister, Bonnie Morrison, and nieces and nephews.
